# **HUMANE SCORECARD**

2013-2014 Wisconsin Legislative Session





#### IN RETROSPECT

7 animal protection bills were introduced into this biennium session.

#### THE GOOD

Woodchucks were spared a killing season in Wisconsin thanks to the concerns of everyday citizens and some legislators as well.

#### THE BAD

No animal-protective legislation made it to the Governor's desk.


#### THE UGLY

Three anti-animal pieces of legislation were signed into law and were a major setback for wildlife.

During the 2013-14 legislative session there were pro-animal bills specific to dogs; animal cruelty (reporting & increasing penalties) and exotic animals. 3/7 received a public hearing. None of those bills made it to the floor for a full vote. Four anti-animal bills were introduced (hunting) and 2/4 bills made it to the governor's desk. The most concerning and damaging bill was the expansion of crossbow use. The vote in the Assembly was unanimous other than one legislator.

Each piece of legislation has its own story too intricate and politically charged to detail completely here. The legislators' scores (%) were weighted based on their commitment to each animal protection bill in the form of authorship, sponsorship, committee and floor votes. Their votes for anti-animal legislation were also weighted in negatively as well. The grades were used to reflect the subtleties hidden in each piece of legislation.

Every state legislator has the opportunity to sign on as a sponsor of a bill. If your legislator had no opportunity for a floor vote on animal-friendly bills, then the question to ask him/her is: "Why didn't you sign on as a co-sponsor of this animal-friendly piece of legislation?"



The intent of this scorecard is to not only highlight legislators' participation in animal-friendly billls, but most importantly to engage WI citizens in the legislative process. ### ASSEMBLY/SENATE BILL DESCRIPTIONS

#### AB 223/SB 136

Possession of dogs by felons and penalties -This bill would have limited a felon's contact with a "vicious" dog and provides penalties for violations. The intent of the word "vicious" is concerning thus LOHV's position is neutral on this bill.

### 2013 WI ACT 20 -MOTION 370

<u>Training unleashed dogs</u> on bears - Motion 370 was

introduced directly into the finance committee's budget bill discussions, similar to riders at the federal level. There are no public hearings for motions and if approved by committee, become law. This motion removed the DNR rule-making authority and made it statutory law that hound dog training on bears will be 60 days (7/1 thru 8/31). Sending packs of unleashed hound dogs into the woods against bears & cubs endangers not only bears but all wildlife; it is unnecessary, inhumane form of recreation.

#### AB 486/SB 399

<u>Crimes Against Animals</u> - Under this bill, a person who treats an animal cruelly is guilty of a Class I felony.

### **AB 703**

<u>Possession of exotic wild animals</u> - This bill prohibits the possession, propagation, and sale of dangerous exotic animals including nonnative cats and bears, apes (gorillas, chimpanzees, gibbons), and crocodilians. It exempts zoos, circuses, research facilities, wildlife sanctuaries and veterinarians.

#### SB 319

Animals taken into custody - Any animals seized e.g. strays or victims of potential abuse, cannot be returned to owner until microchip installed in addition to more seizure and release guidelines meant to protect each animal. Also eliminates euthanization of animals suspected of animal fighting.

**Reporting the mistreatment of animals -** A veterinarian who makes a report of animal mistreatment in good faith is immune from civil liability for making the report.

### ASSEMBLY/SENATE BILL DESCRIPTIONS

#### AB 194/SB 185

Hunting animals with a crossbow - expands the use of crossbows down to 10 yr. olds and adds seasons as well. Crossbows are guns that shoot powerful arrows. The crippling rate in animals using a crossbow is 50% (animals hit but never recovered). With inexperienced children & adults participating in crossbow hunting now, the crippling rate is certain to increase sharply. Inexperienced hunters (young or old) now attracted to this new weapon are not able to effectively track/find mortally wounded animals either. The suffering of animals (wildlife & companion) will only increase. Total authors, co-authors,

#### AB 137/SB164

Killing season on Woodchucks - This bill would redefine the currently "Protected" Woodchuck as a game/fur-bearing animal and establish a 10-month killing season w/ no limits on killing.

#### **AB 397**

Shining Wild Animals - This bill specifies that a person may use a battery operated light designed to be affixed to clothing/part of the body or mounted to the scope of a firearm while hunting on foot for wolves or for raccoons, foxes, coyotes, or other unprotected animals during the open season for the animals hunted. Previously, only handheld flashlights were allowed for such unethical activities.

### AB8/SB210

**Restricting local governmental authority to regulate hunting** - This bill removes local authority to regulate the use of longbow and crossbow for the purposes of hunting within city limits. It also allows the use of bowhunting within 100' of hospital, school or sanitorium.
